First Baptist Church, Nashville, Scholarship Policies

The function of the Scholarship Committee of First Baptist Church Nashville is to administer the Yarborough Scholarship, the Cox Memorial Belmont University Scholarship Award and other church designated scholarship funds. This committee will determine annually who will receive the funds, the individual allocation of the funds, and how the funds will be disseminated.

Each applicant must:

1. Be an active, resident member of FBCN for one year or have been a member for that period of time prior to entering college.
2. Be a full-time student for the school year for which scholarship application is made.
3. Have a minimum Grade Point Average of 2.5/4.0 and a minimum ACT score of 19 or SAT of 1,000.
4. Submit an application for scholarship to the Scholarship Committee by April 16, 2008.
5. Have your Sunday school teacher or department director send a letter of recommendation to the Scholarship Committee by April 16, 2008.
6. Interview with the Scholarship Committee.

The committee will allocate available funds as individual grants according to criteria such as:

- Student Involvement (church, community, school)
- Academic Standing (GPA, ACT Score, Honors/Awards)
- Interview
- Essay/Recommendations
- Career Goals

All information submitted to the Scholarship Committee is considered privileged and confidential and is intended solely for use by the committee. Any other use of this material is prohibited. At the end of the process the applicants will receive written notice of whether or not they will receive a scholarship and other appropriate information.
